She is scheduled to conduct the Nelson Symphony Orchestra in 2024. Beth has also served as adjudicator and guest conductor with the KBB and NZCBA music festivals. In 2022 Beth completed her Doctorate at Canterbury University entitled: Classical music and audience engagement: Updating the Bernstein Model.
